

## OUR STORY

On August 20, 2011, the Missoula Symphony Association and the Missoula Symphony Guild are jointly hosting the second annual Cycle for the Symphony, C4S, bicycle ride to raise awareness and funds for the Missoula Symphony Association.

The Missoula Symphony Orchestra presents a five-concert season, featuring two performances of each concert, as well as two Youth Concerts for children within a 100 mile radius of Missoula and a Family Concert. In appreciation of tremendous community support, the Symphony also performs a free outdoor summer concert. Established in 1954 and now celebrating its 56th season, the Symphony Association has grown to a current operating budget of just under \$400,000. The Association employs a Music Director, Executive Director, and support staff to provide a very high quality musical product and other cultural activities for Missoula and the surrounding area.

The C4S benefit ride is 119 miles and will begin and end in Philipsburg after traveling the Flint Creek Ramble. Not only will this benefit ride be a physical challenge it will be an inspirational journey for those who ride. The C4S ride represents an outpouring of support and appreciation for our talented orchestra members, conductors, chorale and staff, as well as validation of our mission to support the arts in Western Montana.

The C4S ride will include breakfast, lunch, and an energy stop. There will be a host of volunteers along the route to provide bicycle service and support as well as attend to any first aid. After a great ride there will be a finale barbecue in Philipsburg where riders will be hosted by volunteers in celebration of a triumphant ride. C4S promises to be a dynamic fundraising event—one that celebrates the beauty of Western Montana and the joy that music brings to people's lives.
